Kids tend to view friends as those who have similar interests. You can help build a child's friendships skills when you play games that show child ways they are the same with the other children.

Just Like Me

- To play, gather a group of children together and have them sit down in a circle.
- Choose a child to begin the game, the child gets in the middle of the circle and states something he or she likes doing such as **"I like to ride my bike" or "I have a younger brother."** If the statement is true for any of the other children, they should stand up and say, **"That's just like me!"**
- Continue until each person has had a turn.

When the game is over, take the opportunity to share what having same interest means.
