Lions Group

Students enrolled in this group are often ready to learn the following 3 core social skills:

- 1. **Self -Regulation Skills** (recognize and understanding one's own emotions as well as emotions that are expressed by others. Read other's cues and body language)
- 2. **Conversational Skills** (greet others, share and listen to information, starting a conversation, maintaining a conversation, change topics, make comments, ask questions, announcing one's actions, listening, body language).
- 3. **Problem Solving Skills** (deciding if it is fair, sharing, playing with others, friendship rules, making choices, knowing what to do, talking it through, teasing etc.)
