This group offers opportunities for children to learn to solve conflicts, talk it out and to know about their feelings. The kids in this group have the language skills of toddlers and preschoolers. Our groups are purposely kept small to encourage 1 to 1 attention. In this group we only accept 3 children and 2 to 3 peers volunteer.

This group runs twice a week for 4 weeks. Tuition is all-inclusive and covers meals, field trips, as well as instruction and all course material. Tuition: \$1668 for the entire session enrolled (additional 3% discount if tuition is paid in full). Weekly tuition \$417.00)

Goal: Teaching social skills through fun, exciting activities!

- We discuss social expectations of friendships by role playing and modeling.
- We define the different levels of friendships (acquaintances, casual friends, best friends etc.).
- We encourage active and reflective body language and understanding of subtle para-verbal messages.
- We learn how to show interest in other people's conversation, and how to shift topics.
- We assist the students in communicating effectively.
- We are taught how get our points across and how to use reasoning skills effectively.
- We practice skills in the community engaging in fun adventures such as, shopping and baking adventures, water day, science and adventure, make and take etc.
